Here it is. . .the first review. . .the Finish Line shop apron!!! First thing first, yes, I realize it is merely an apron for working on your bike, and #2, I also realize that the "thumbs up" expression is not cool anymore. Both are still cool to me.

Now. . .on to the Apron. As far as shop aprons go, this HAS to be the most innovative apron I have ever seen. That metal plate over my chest may not protect me from bullets, it is magnetic though, and is great for sticking a washer to yourself for a quick second (it is also strong enough to hold your bottle caps too!). There is a mesh pocket on the side to put your tools/parts in, and being mesh, you can see them in there too. With 8 pockets total, you can walk around with your whole workbench strapped to your chest, and still be able to find everything when you need it. This apron is also adjustable. If you look at the picture on the left, you can see it the short way, and on the right, the long way. There is also a length in between, but I figured you only wanted to see me twice.

Now, the negatives. While far and few between, the biggest negative is the strap system to get it on and off when compared to other aprons. Maybe I am just an idiot, but this is not an apron that you can whip on and off in a matter of seconds. It can take up to 20 seconds to get this thing on and off. Not much, but just be forewarned.

All in all, I would DEFINETLY recommend this apron to anyone. At the shop, this is what I switched us all to. It feels like a heavier material than other aprons out there, and there is even a little hook to clip a rag to so you can have one ready at all times. If you are looking for an innovative shop apron to work on your bike, this is it. If you want an apron to bake cookies, buy something else.
